They can consume every organic substance including coffee. Cockroaches are attracted to coffee in your pantry or kitchen cabinet but they prefer crumbs or other sugary objects more than coffee. However, according to some reports, excessive coffee consumption can also negatively affect cockroaches. Are cockroaches attracted to alcohol? Cockroas can also be attracted to sweet sweets or drinks. They show attractions to alcoholic beverages, especially to beer. They can detect the sweet smell of drinks from far away and will happily come to consume them. Are cockroaches attracted by sodium bicarbonate? Sodium bicarbonate does not attract cockroaches. However, a mixture of sodium and sugar bicarbonate is used to get rid of them. Sodium bicarbonate and sugar sugar are usually sprinkled in almost infested areas. The sugar scent in the mixture will attract cockroaches and after having consumed the mix that kills them slowly. Are cockroaches attracted to Popcorn? Cockroads love to eat popcorn. If you leave popcorn in an open container at night, you will certainly attract cockroaches. Therefore, you should keep the popcorn and other snacks in a strictly sealed container to prevent a cockroach infestation in your home. Are cockroaches attracted to desserts? Cockroaches love desserts or products based on starch such as jams, jellies, cakes, fruit juices, drinks, biscuits, candies, etc. Although consumer plants and meat like their food source love sweet objects more than other organic products. They can smell the sweet food through their antenna and invade your home leaving their tracks behind for other cockroaches to follow. Some cockroaches communicate through the bacteria present in their feces. Onions attract cockroaches? Cockroas are not attracted to the onions but have no problem eating them. Some people also use a mixture of cayenne onion and pepper to kill cockroaches but this is not really so effective. The onion helps to repel the cockroaches only because of their strong pungent smell but that smell can evaporate quite easily. Potatoes attract cockroaches? Potatoes and other starch products are some of the favorite cockroaches. If you leave potatoes in an open sack or in a container, you will increase your chances of attracting an invasion of cockroach. Do not leave pieces of potatoes in your kitchen at night, store potatoes in a thick plastic container and you will not attract these annoying parasites. Apple cider vinegar attracts cockroaches? Apple Cider vinegar is used as naturalRepellent which means that does not attract cockroaches. It is a disinfectant and acts as a detergent agent to get rid of spots and odors that can attract cockroaches and other parasites. You can also use it to clean the kitchen or other potential nesting sites to avoid the invasion of cockroach. Coconut oil attracts cockroaches?
